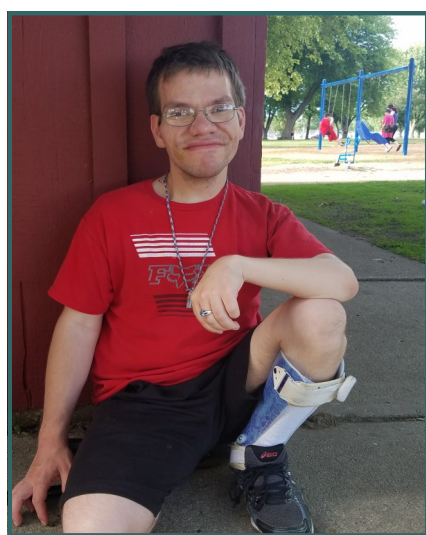

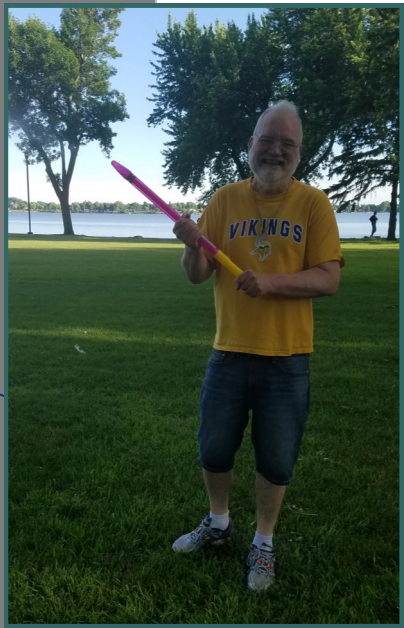
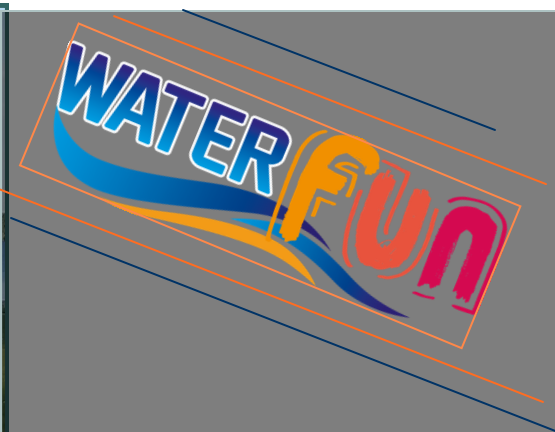

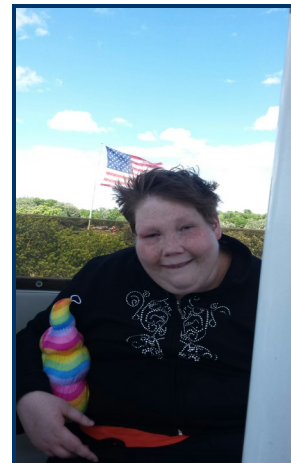


HILLCREST GIRLS HIT OKOBOJI
